A Friday traffic stop left a Sugar Grove woman facing drug trafficking charges.

Deputies stopped 45-year-old Sherrie Gragg Harmon's vehicle when it allegedly failed to stop at a stop sign. Harmon was charged with felony conspiracy to traffic opium, as well as other drug charges for illegal possession of the pills. Harmon was held on a \$27,000 bond.
