 - Trick-or-Treat for Tots at Appalachian State University, from 5-7 this evening. In that, children are invited to trick-or-treat at any East Campus residence halls. Also on campus;
 - Don Winsley's Electric Halloween at Legends, 9 p.m. Admission is \$4 for advance tickets or \$6 at the door.
 - Halloween Monster Concert, at 8 p.m. in Broyhill Music Center's Rosen Concert Hall. Admission is free and costumes are encouraged.
 - Halloween Ball, tonight at 8 p.m. in the Plemmons Student Union at Appalachian. Admission is \$5 in advance and \$7 at the door.

- Trunk or Treat at Howard's Creek Baptist Church starts at 6 p.m.
 - Trunk or Treat at Boone United Methodist Church, is from 6:30-8 p.m.
 - Mount Vernon Baptist Church Fall Festival, is from 5:30 to 8 p.m.
- And rounding out the Halloween festivities; the Ghost Train at Tweetsie Railroad, Nov. 1-2. Gates open at 7:30 p.m. Admission is \$28 per person. Children under 2 free.
