A board of adjustment meeting next Monday will help determine whether Lenny Cottom will get his ski expansion.

Next week is only the preliminary meeting. While questions will be asked and expansion discussed, a decision on the expansion will not be reached until the Board of Adjustment's regular meeting a week from Monday.

Town Council and Board of Adjustment member Bill Wilkinson will not take part in the vote on expansion, however. At a recent Tourism Development Authority meeting where Wilkinson is also a member, a vote on whether to support Cottom's expansion took place. Wilkinson voted
