- Have children carry a flashlight or glowstick or wear reflective tape that can be seen at night
- Adults or older, responsible siblings should accompany young children
- Don't let kids eat treats until an adult has inspected them
- Remind kids not to enter a strange house or car
- Be extra cautious on the roads if you are driving.
