

High Country Counties See Unemployment Rise

The Employment Security Commission has released County unemployment rates for January. High Country Counties followed the increase in statewide unemployment rates during that period.

North Carolina unemployment increased from 4.7% in December to 5.0% in January. Ashe County Unemployment increased from 5.9% in December to 7.3% in January. Avery County's unemployment increased from 5.3% to 6.1%. Watauga County's unemployment increased slightly from 3.5% to 3.8%. Although the state's employment increased overall during this period, 98 out of 100 of the state's counties experienced increases in unemployment.
