Six Departments on Tenatious Woods Fire

Six fire departments from Watauga, Wilkes and Caldwell are on the scene of a large woods fire on the border area of the three counties. One issue is the location of the fire is causing a number of smoke reports, most of which have turned out to be the fire in the Sampson area. But with ashes being blown even into Boone from the fire, each call has been investigated, sometimes taking away from the effort at the scene. Dry, windy conditions are contributing to the danger and the spread of the fire.
