The Town of Seven Devils "Vision Statement" begins:

"The Town of Seven Devils is a residential and recreational community whose citizens and governance are committed to managing its growth, with a primary focus on owner-occupied single-family homes and on the preservation and enhancement of the distinctive and irreplaceable natural beauty of its mountain setting."

A year ago the owners of the golf course property in Seven Devils, for their sole benefit, closed the golf course and put up "NO TRESPASSING" signs

Denying access by the citizens of Seven Devils, reducing the summer recreational acreage by 89% and significantly reducing property values in the Town. The Town has done a good job of preventing major destructive construction on the property but has done little to secure the land
