

Mountaineer Football Notebook: ASU Selects Captains

Nose tackle Chris Aiken (Austin, Texas/Reagan), linebacker Demery Brewer (Lincolnton, N.C./Lincolnton), offensive lineman Orry Frye (Charlotte, N.C./Providence), cornerback Ed Gainey (Winston-Salem, N.C./Mount Tabor), quarterback DeAndre Presley (Tampa, Fla./Middleton) and wide receiver Brian Quick (Columbia, S.C./Ridge View) have been selected as Appalachian State University football's team captains for the 2011 season, head coach Jerry Moore announced on Tuesday. The six captains were selected in a vote by the team's players.

"Our six captains are great leaders and obviously well-respected by their teammates," Moore said. "The leadership that they provide is invaluable to our program."

The 68 ACC Network affiliates airing Saturday's broadcast range from coast to coast, with stations as far as Boston, Miami, Los Angeles and Green Bay carrying the ASU-VT showdown.
