The Cougars won the opening set 25-17, but the Pioneers (9-2 overall; 4-0 NW3A/4A) bounced back to win the next three games, 25-16, 25-20, 25-20.

"I was real impressed with Alexander Central," said WHS coach Kris Hagaman. "They came out real aggressive in the first game and caught us off guard. But the girls regrouped and we won a big conference match on the road."
