Monday. The one-day camp will be held on the Lees-McRae campus and will feature multiple training sessions with college coaches, a college preparatory talk, and a campus tour. The camp is open to players aged 13-18 at a cost of \$100 each, and includes lunch. Campers should bring with them cleats, shin guards, athletic clothing, running shoes, a water bottle, and anything else they might need to compete at a high level.
