Lenoir-Rhyne's Imari Davis and Steven McGhee have been named the Deep South Conference Men's Lacrosse Offensive and Defensive Players Of The Week, respectively, league officials announced this

Davis, a junior midfielder from San Diego, Calif., finished the week with four goals and five assists and scored twice in both matches to lead the Bears to the wins.
