

Beech Lowers Water Restrictions

The Town of Beech Mountain has lowered its water restrictions from Stage 3, Mandatory Water Reduction II to Stage 2, Mandatory Water Reduction I status. Water supply conditions have improved but continue to be significantly lower than the seasonal norm.

Customers must continue to reduce water use by 10%. In Stage 2, the following restrictions apply:

- irrigation is limited to a half inch per week between 8PM and 8AM;
- washing only full loads in clothes and dishwashers;
- preventing water waste and runoff;
- using spring-loaded nozzles on garden hoses;
- identifying and repairing all water leaks
- outdoor use of drinking water for washing impervious surfaces is prohibited;
- all testing and training purposes requiring drinking water (e.g. fire protection) will be limited.

Penalties (listed below) apply for noncompliance.
