

Police hopes suspects won't weasel away

Police are looking for someone responsible for stealing credit cards in the Ingle's parking lot Sunday- and believe the suspect is armed with a ferret.

Police are also looking for an accomplice, a white male, approximately 35 to 38 years old with blonde wavy hair, approximately 5'8" to 5'9" in height, with very tan skin.
