High Country Crime Stoppers and Boone Police seek the public's assistance in solving the following crime: On March 28th, 2013, a Grey 2000 GMC Sierra single cab pickup truck, with North Carolina registration tag AMR-5347, was stolen out of the Chili's parking lot in Boone. The owner of the vehicle was attempting to sell the vehicle and allowed a couple to take the vehicle for a test drive, but they never returned. The suspects are described as a white male in his thirties, very thin, with a light, scruffy beard, wearing a black beanie cap and a sweatshirt. The second suspect is described as a white female, also in her thirties, with shoulder-length brown hair, wearing a brown jacket.
