

Creston Man Charged with Meth Manufacturing

Ashe Sheriff James Williams reports that the Ashe County Sheriff's Office Narcotics Unit discovered 3 different "One-Pot" Methamphetamine Labs at a Creston home, and has arrested an Ashe County man. Gene Edward Allen of Creston was arrested on January 15th after investigators visited his home and discovered the labs. Gene Allen was charged with Manufacturing Methamphetamine, Possession of an Immediate Precursor Chemical with the Intent to Manufacture Methamphetamine and Maintaining a Dwelling used for keeping a Controlled Substance.
