

Suspect Sought in Pharmacy Break-In

The Watauga County Sheriff's Office is seeking help in identifying the perpetrator who forced entry to the Foscoe Pharmacy last month. The incident took place on February 14th at about 1:00 AM, with the suspect forcing the back door to the pharmacy. There was only one item stolen from the pharmacy, but the release did not indicate what that might have been. The video footage shows the suspect dressed in a dark hooded sweatshirt, and stills from that video are posted on this article.
