According to a statement released yesterday, the Carolinas Blood Services Region of the American Red Cross, there is less than a day's supply of most blood types. While all blood types are needed, a special need exists for types O and B. A drop in the blood supply is typical of the summer season. When schools and colleges close and people are on vacations, people tend to donate less. The shortage, however, has occurred earlier in the season this year, and the Red Cross fears the upcoming July 4th holiday will make the situation worse.
