

Trio Charged in Various Drug Counts

A number of drug counts were filed against three people after a search warrant was served on April 22nd by narcotics detectives from the Watauga County Sheriff's Office. The search was made at 405 Holiday Hills, Boone, the warrant granted to search in reference to the sell and distribution of Heroin. Paul Isaac Holmes, 22, and 20-year old Anna Lynne Strain were charged with Possession of Heroin, Possession of MDMA, Felony Maintain a Dwelling for Controlled Substances, Simple Possession of Schedule II Suboxone, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Sarah Renee Lafaille, 21, was charged with Possession of Psilocybin Mushrooms, Possession of LSD, Felony Maintaining a Dwelling Controlled Substances, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Holmes, Strain, and Lafaille were held at the Watauga County Detection Facility under \$10,000 bond with a District Court appearance set May 28th.
