

WHS Baseball Announces Schedule Change

Watauga High baseball coach Pete Hardee has announced that the Pioneers will entertain Providence in a double-header on Saturday May, 16 at Pioneer Field.

It will be varsity only, beginning with the first game at 12 noon. The double-header includes a make-up game that was rained out at Providence on March 26. The North Davidson game that was postponed April 2 has yet to be rescheduled. Hardee hopes to get that game made up in the next two weeks.
