The official verbiage from the NWS is: Saturday Night...Cloudy with a chance of rain showers. A chance of snow showers after midnight. Lows in the lower 30s. Chance of precipitation 50 percent. Christmas Day...A chance of snow in the morning. Cloudy with a chance of rain. Highs in the lower 40s. Chance of precipitation 50 percent.
