- Cost, which includes meet-and-greet and clinic, lunch and a ticket to that afternoon's Mountaineer basketball doubleheader (men vs. Wofford at 2 p.m., women vs. UNCG at 4:30 p.m.) is just \$20 per person
- Event is open to ladies only, ages 15 and up (participants under 18 must be accompanied by an adult)

- Bobby Richardson, an eight-time All-Star and three-time World Series champion with the New York Yankees from 1955-66, is the keynote speaker
- Banquet begins with a cocktail hour at 5:45 p.m., followed by dinner and program at 7 p.m.
