

Hiatt Named SAC Women's Basketball Player Of Week

Lenoir-Rhyne University's Jordan Hiatt has been named the South Atlantic Conference Women's Basketball Player Of The Week, league officials announced this afternoon. Hiatt, a freshman guard from

Mount Airy, N.C., averaged 13.3 points, 6.3 rebounds and 4.3 assists in leading the Bears to 2-1 week. Hiatt also shot 60.9 percent (14-of-23) from the field and 90 percent (nine-of-10) from the charity stripe.

Hiatt led all scorers with 19 points to go along with six assists and five rebounds while connecting on seven-of-eight shots in a 68-60 victory over Winston-Salem State last Tuesday night in the home opener.

Hiatt added 12 points and a team-high eight rebounds to pace L-R in a 74-61 victory over North Georgia Saturday afternoon on the first day of the Loch Shop Classic in Morrow, Ga. The victory increased the Bears' win streak to four games.

Hiatt is currently second in points (10.7 ppg) and first in rebounds (5.2 rpg) and assists (3.0 apg) this year for the Bears. Hiatt is also shooting 91 percent (19-of-21) from the free throw line.

Lenoir-Rhyne (4-2) will next host Carson-Newman in its South Atlantic Conference opener on Saturday, December 15, at 2:00 p.m., in Shuford Memorial Gymnasium.
