

Bears 14th After Day One Of The Spring Kickoff

The Lenoir-Rhyne Men's Golf Team shot a 310 (+26) and sits in 14th place after the first day Monday of the Spring Kickoff Intercollegiate at the Golf Club at Fleming Island.

Georgia Southwestern State leads after the first round of play with a 286 (+2) on the par-71, 6,688-yard course.

Georgia Southwestern State's Nate Gahman, Montevallo's Juan Noce and Wingate's Brian Denton are tied for first with a two-under 69 while sophomore Drew Alford (Statesville, N.C.) is Lenoir-Rhyne's top golfer after the first 18 holes of play.

Alford is tied for ninth after carding a 72 (+1) for the first round while junior John White (Dudley Shoals, N.C.) and freshman David Donovan (Hampstead, N.C.) both tied for 56th with a 79 (+8) for the Bears.

The two-day tournament concludes with the second round on Tuesday. Wingate and Lincoln Memorial are serving as the co-hosts of the tournament this year.
