

Stallings, Crawford Earn SoCon Honors

Davidson junior Andrew Lantz and Appalachian State senior Jared Stalling have been named the Southern Conference's Men's Outdoor Track and Field Athletes of the Week for meets over last weekend. The selections are made by the

league's track and field coaches.

Stalling finished third in the shot put at the Wake Forest Open in a personal best of 55' 11" (17.04m). This mark is the fourth best in school history. He also took sixth in the hammer throw with a toss of 184' 3" (56.15m) and finished second in the discus with a throw of 166' 3" (50.68m). He leads the conference in all three throws.

Western Carolina junior Jocelyn Keen and Appalachian State's Cassie Crawford have been named the Southern Conference's Women's Outdoor Track and Field Athletes of the Week for meets over last weekend. The selections are made by the league's track and field coaches. Crawford, an Apex, N.C., native, placed second at the Wake Forest Invitational with a vault of 12-5.50. Appalachian State returns to action on both the men's and women's sides when they head to the High Point Invitational on Saturday.
