

L-R Men, Women Finish Third At SE Regionals

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Both the Lenoir-Rhyne Men's and Women's Track and Field Teams finished third at the Southeast Regional Championships which concluded Saturday at the Irwin Belk Track at the Moretz Sports - Athletic Complex. Wingate took the women's title with 276 points while Mars Hill (193 points) placed first on the men's side. Lenoir-Rhyne recorded 10 first-place finishes over the weekend and were led by senior Jamont Jones (Washington, N.C.).

Jones won both the men's 100-meter (10.90) and 200-meter (21.46) dashes and was part of the men's 400-meter relay team which placed first overall with a school-record 41.47 for the Bears. In addition, redshirt freshman Kevin Baxter (Columbia, S.C.) broke the school record in the men's 110-meter hurdles with a winning time of 14.34 seconds.

Baxter has already qualified for the national championship in the event. Several other first-place finishes in the meet included senior Artis Gilmore (Asheville, N.C.) in the men's triple jump (46'10") and freshman Vertrice Wilson (Carrollton, Ga.) in the women's 100-meter hurdles with a school-record time of 15.15.

The 2013 NCAA Division II Outdoor Track and Field National Championships will take place on May 23-25 in Pueblo, Colo.
