

## Fireworks Display to Cap Home Opener

The fireworks display that was postponed following Appalachian State University's soggy Fan Fest on Aug. 17 will now be held following the conclusion of the Mountaineers' home opener versus North Carolina A&T on Sept. 7 at Kidd Brewer Stadium. Kickoff is set for 6 p.m.

The fireworks display will begin shortly after the conclusion of the contest between Appalachian State and N.C. A&T. Following the pyrotechnics, fans are encouraged to stay in the stands for postgame concerts by the North Carolina A&T and Appalachian State marching bands (the Blue & Gold Marching Machine and North Carolina's Band of Distinction, respectively).
