

ASU Women's Soccer Falls to Colorado College

Appalachian State University women's soccer fell in its opening game this weekend to the host Tigers of Colorado College. The Tigers proved to be a strong test for the Mountaineers on Friday afternoon. Colorado College outshot the Apps by a 23 to three advantage.
