

ASU Women's Ninth at Low Country Intercollegiate

The Appalachian State University women's golf team finished the sixth annual Low Country Intercollegiate in ninth place with a two-round score of 681 at the par-72, 5,815 yard Moses Creek Golf

Club in Hilton Head, S.C.

After the first day of the tournament, freshman Emily Stinson (Charlotte, N.C./Ardey Kell) and junior Haley Zagoria (Atlanta, Ga./Woodward Academy) held the top spots for Appalachian. Both carded a nine-over-par 81. Stinson was able to secure the top spot for the Mountaineers finishing two strokes better than Zagoria. Stinson finished tied for 22nd place overall and Zagoria finished tied for 26th place overall.

Sophomore Hannah Craver (Winston-Salem, N.C./Reagan) began the day tied in 38th place and shot just one stroke worst than her first round. She finished the tournament tied for 35th place and carded a 27-over-par 171.

Sophomore Lily Yatawara (Salisbury, N.C./Salisbury) and sophomore Madalyn Davis (Marion, N.C./McDowell) both settled at 50th place finishing with a 40-over-par 184.
