Deputy Town of Boone Clerk, Kim Brown's daughter plays softball at Watauga. Brown said proceeds will be donated to Ashlyn Pope, a senior and softball player from Hibriten High School. She and her father were involved in a wreck with a drunk driver last October. Pope took the majority of the impact and was pinned in the vehicle. Pope suffered severe multi-system trauma and broke her legs, arms, a vertebrae in her back, and her jaw.

The supper will be held tomorrow evening from 5:00 – 8:00 at the Greenway Church Gym in Boone. There's no set cost for the supper, but donations will be accepted.
